





GLOBAL PARTNERSHIPS

Global has been working on three projects with DIN Malawi: **Tiasamale HIV, Go Girls,** and **YEEP**. We are continuing entrepreneurship lesson plans for YEEP to support DIN's small business initiative. We are compiling information on nutrition and HIV management for DIN's HIV support group. We are working with Go Girls to create lessons related to sexual and reproductive health.

COMMUNICATIONS

Comms started a new movement to improve chapter culture documentation through two projects. With the **Pitch Project**, we surveyed members to find important aspects of the GlobeMed experience for marketing and recruitment seasons. With our **quarterly one-pagers**, starting with this document, we want to broadcast chapter accomplishments.

RESEARCH & EDUCATE

R&E started a lesson curriculum on the politics and financing of **nutrition**, such as intricacies in food pricing, difficulties facing American farmers, and nutrition education and marketing. We had discussions on food deserts within our local community and childhood obesity. Lastly, we are launching **individual year-long research projects** that target different community health issues.

CAMPAIGNS

Campaigns fundraised with two bun sales and a ROTI partnership **fundraisers**. We also began **grant writing** to help DIN Malawi apply for funds for their The Right To Be a Girl project. Additionally, we have a speaker from the Pozen Center for Human Rights lined up for the Winter quarter **Lunch & Learn** on how service learning curriculums can impact violence prevention in Chicago.

INTERNAL DEV

Internal was active in **recruitment** and **outreach** events, especially on-boarding and **integration** of new members into the GlobeMed community. We are developing a database of members' skills/experiences to create mentorship opportunities. For next quarter, we are planning a workshop on Seasonal Affective Disorder in collaboration with other health RSO's and GlobeMed **chapters** in the Chicago area.

LOCAL PARTNERSHIPS

Local has worked on researching potential **partnership** organizations, finalizing the logistics of a partner search group, and looking into a **collaboration** with another RSO. As the details of this collaboration are finalized, Local Partnerships looks forward to hitting the ground running next quarter to develop this new collaboration and find a new local partner for our chapter.
